



FINANCIAL POLICY

Effective November 1, 2009

Payment for outpatient services is due at the time services are rendered.

If your pet is admitted, you will be given a written estimate of the recommended diagnostic and therapeutic procedures and will be required to leave a deposit of no less than 50% of the estimated charges. You should read the terms and conditions of the estimate, and if you have any questions, ask for clarification. The balance of your account is due at the time of discharge. If your pet's condition requires significantly more medical or surgical care than was anticipated, the attending veterinarian will discuss the various options with you. You may be asked to make an additional deposit toward your bill. Again, the balance of your account will be due at the time of discharge.

In the event owner will send an agent to pick up at time of discharge, full estimate payment will be required upon check in.
